The first JJI Exile Brothers release is a truly amazing album of music... it's a story of birth, breath, love, life and death on the Himalayan mountains. JJI EXILE BROTHERS are the voice in exile of Tibetans everywhere. Taken to safety in India by their mum, the three brothers, Jigme, Jamyang and Ingsel, have grown up in exile and fused traditional Tibetan instruments with western influences to make their very own brand of new Buddhist music. It's a ceremony straight out of the Jim Morrison book of rock. Imagine Bob Marley and Sitting Bull reincarnated as Tibetans in exile singing in a band, and you'll get an idea of the feelings behind songs like 'Stand Up' and the haunting melody of 'If'. Their sound reverberates with echoes of the West: the Doors and Neil Young are there, and yet it's all wrapped up in passionate Tibetan 3-part vocal harmonies, soaring guitars, and the Brothers' own acoustic Tibetan chill-out prayer. This album is a mixture of acoustic serenity and electric protest... the songs reflect a yearning desire and hope for freedom underscored by years of pain. It's simply beautiful.
